## Match background

---

The only side confirmed as group winners after four rounds of matches, Liverpool welcome Porto to Anfield seeking another emphatic victory against the Portuguese side.

- The Reds have won all four games in Group B including a 5-1 triumph at Porto on Matchday 2, Mohamed Salah (18, 60) and Roberto Firmino (77, 81) both scoring twice with Sadio Mané getting the other (45). A 75th-minute Mehdi Taremi response was all Porto could manage, meaning they have now never beaten Liverpool in nine attempts (D3 L6).
- Liverpool have also defeated AC Milan at home (3-2) and Atlético de Madrid away (3-2) and home (2-0) to open up a seven-point lead in the group and confirm their round of 16 place with two matches to spare.
- Porto, who drew at both Atlético (0-0) and Milan (1-1) and beat the Italian side 1-0 at home on Matchday 3, are second on five points, one above Atleti. They will go through if they beat Liverpool and Atlético lose at home to Milan in the section's other Matchday 5 fixture.

### Previous meetings

- Liverpool's victory in the 2018/19 UEFA Champions League featured an emphatic quarter-final win against Porto; Naby Keïta (5) and Firmino (26) got the goals in the first leg at Anfield before a 4-1 away success at the Dragão. Mané (26) and Salah (65) increased the aggregate advantage before late goals from Firmino (77) and Virgil van Dijk (84) after Éder Militão (69) had pulled one back for Porto.
- In 2017/18, a Mané hat-trick at the Dragão helped Liverpool to a 5-0 first-leg victory in the round of 16, Salah and Firmino also finding the net. The second leg at Anfield finished goalless.
- Sérgio Conceição and Jürgen Klopp were the respective coaches of Porto and Liverpool for both those ties.
- All nine of the matches between the teams have come in the 21st century. Their first came in the quarter-finals of Liverpool's victorious 2000/01 UEFA Cup campaign; Gérard Houllier's side drew the first leg 0-0 in Portugal before first-half goals from Danny Murphy and Michael Owen secured a 2-0 second-leg, and aggregate, victory at Anfield.
- The other matches came in the 2007/08 UEFA Champions League group stage. Dirk Kuyt's 17th-minute goal earned Liverpool a 1-1 Matchday 1 draw at Jesualdo Ferreira's Porto, who had gone in front through Lucho González's eighth-minute penalty. The visitors played the majority of the second half with ten men following Jermaine Pennant's 58th-minute red card.
- At Anfield, Lisandro (33) cancelled out Fernando Torres' 19th-minute opener for Rafael Benítez's Liverpool, before late goals from Torres again (78), Steven Gerrard (84pen) and Peter Crouch (87) gave the home team the points. Porto and Liverpool both went through to the last 16, the Portuguese side winning the section; Liverpool went on to reach the semi-finals.

### Form guide

#### Liverpool

- Liverpool are in the UEFA Champions League group stage for the 14th time; they have only failed to progress to the last 16 or further three times.
- This is Liverpool's fifth successive group campaign, all under Jürgen Klopp; runners-up to Real Madrid in the 2017/18 final, they claimed their sixth European Cup at the expense of Tottenham with a 2-0 victory in the 2018/19 final, goals from Salah and Divock Origi securing the trophy at Atlético's Estadio Metropolitano in Madrid.
- Liverpool's last two UEFA Champions League campaigns have ended in defeat against clubs from Madrid. Dethroned by Atlético in the 2019/20 round of 16 (0-1 a, 2-3 h aet), they lost to Real Madrid in last season's quarter-finals (1-3 a, 0-0 h).
- Klopp's side had finished first in Group D on 13 points, ahead of Atalanta, Ajax and Midtjylland, before beating Leipzig 2-0 in both legs of their round of 16 tie with both games played in Budapest.
- Champions of England for the 19th time in 2019/20, their first league title since 1990, Liverpool finished third in the 2020/21 Premier League.
- Liverpool have won five of their last eight UEFA Champions League matches at Anfield (D1 L2).
- Liverpool are one of four sides to have won their first four games, along with Ajax (Group C), Bayern München (E) and Juventus (H).
- A 2-0 second-leg loss to Benfica in the 2005/06 UEFA Champions League round of 16 (0-3 aggregate) is Liverpool's only defeat at home to Portuguese visitors (W7 D3).

#### Porto

- This is Porto's 25th UEFA Champions League group campaign, fewer only than Real Madrid and Barcelona (both 26).
- The Portuguese side have qualified for the last 16 on each of their last four appearances in the group stage.
- In 2020/21, Porto finished second in Group C behind Manchester City and ahead of Olympiacos and Marseille. They lost their first game, 3-1 in Manchester, but then remained unbeaten and kept clean sheets in each of the next five (W4 D1).
- In the round of 16, Porto were 2-1 winners at home to Juventus in the first leg, going through on away goals after a 3-2 extra-time defeat in Turin with Sérgio Oliveira's 115th-minute free-kick – his second goal of the game – proving decisive.
- Both legs of the quarter-final against Chelsea were played in Seville, the English club winning the first leg 2-0 and going through despite a 1-0 second-leg defeat.
- Porto finished second in the 2020/21 Portuguese Liga, five points behind champions Sporting CP.
- Porto have lost six of their last nine fixtures against English opponents, last season's 1-0 win against Chelsea in the quarter-final second leg their only victory in that run.
- The Dragons have never won in England where their record is D3 L17 F11 A53 with defeats in seven of their last eight trips. Luis Díaz's early goal in a 3-1 loss at Manchester City on Matchday 1 last season was Porto's first in eight visits to England, where they have conceded 18 goals in that time.
- Porto have won eight of their last 18 matches in the UEFA Champions League proper (D3 L7); last season's defeat at Juventus is their only loss in their last six away games (W3 D2).

#### Links and trivia

- Diogo Jota spent 2016/17 on loan at Porto from Atlético, scoring nine goals in 37 games in all competitions. Iván Marcano, Sérgio Oliveira, Otávio and Jesús Corona were among his team-mates.
- Jota scored past current Porto goalkeeper Cláudio Ramos in a 4-0 success at home to Tondela on 17 February 2017.
- Jota also played for Paços de Ferreira between 2013 and 2016. He made two Liga appearances against Porto, in a 2-1 defeat at the Dragão on 5 December 2015 and a 1-0 home win on 10 April 2016 in which he scored the only goal.

- Pepe briefly crossed paths with Fabinho at Real Madrid in 2012/13, the latter making only one senior appearance in what proved his sole campaign with the club.
- During the summer Grujić sealed a permanent transfer to Porto after a season-long loan from Liverpool, the club he joined in 2015. He made eight Premier League appearances for the Reds, all as a substitute.
- Toni Martínez and Adrián were West Ham team-mates between 2016 and 2018, the Spanish striker mostly featuring in the club's Under-21 and Under-23 teams while his compatriot was involved with the senior squad.

#### Latest news

##### Liverpool

- Liverpool's record in this season's Premier League is W7 D4 L1. They were 4-0 winners at home to Arsenal on Saturday.
- Trent Alexander-Arnold set up two of the goals and has 38 assists since the start of the 2018/19 Premier League season, four more than any other player.
- The Reds surrendered the English top flight's last unbeaten record this season on 7 November, when they went down 3-2 at West Ham.
- That ended the Merseyside club's 25-game sequence without defeat in all competitions (W18 D7), stretching back to the 3-1 loss at Real Madrid in last season's UEFA Champions League quarter-final first leg.
- The Reds have won only three of their six Premier League home games this season, drawing the other three.



- Liverpool recorded successive 5-0 away wins, at Watford on 16 October and Manchester United eight days later. That was only the second time they had managed consecutive league victories by five or more goals, and the first since April 1935.
- Liverpool were also only the second team in English top-flight history to win consecutive away games by a margin of five or more goals without conceding themselves, after Manchester United in February-March 1960.
- Liverpool have scored 53 goals in 18 games this season, including five in three of their last ten matches.
- The Reds have scored two or more goals in 17 of their 18 games in all competitions this season, the exception the 1-1 Premier League draw against Chelsea at Anfield on 28 August.
- Mohamed Salah, who hit a hat-trick at United, scored in ten successive Liverpool games, 14 goals in all, between 28 August and 24 October but had not found the net in three appearances before scoring against Arsenal at the weekend. He is still the Premier League's top scorer with 11 goals, four more than any other player.
- Salah's goal at Norwich on 14 August made him the first player ever to score in the opening Premier League game five seasons in a row.
- Salah was named Premier League player of the month for October, while his strike in the 2-2 home draw against Manchester City on 3 October was selected as goal of the month.
- Jürgen Klopp's side will be at home to Leicester in the League Cup quarter-finals on 22 December.
- Alexander-Arnold provided three assists as England won 10-0 in San Marino on 15 November to book their place in next year's FIFA World Cup.
- Jordan Henderson played 90 minutes of England's 5-0 home win against Albania on 12 November, scoring the third goal – just his second in 68 appearances – but missed the win in San Marino through injury while Andy Robertson was replaced late on in Scotland's 2-0 win at home to Denmark on 15 November. Three days earlier, Robertson had also captained Scotland to a 2-0 win in Moldova that sealed a play-off place.
- Virgil van Dijk captained the Netherlands to a 2-0 home win against Norway on 16 November as they also reached the finals.
- Neco Williams scored Wales' second goal in a 5-1 home win against Belarus on 13 November.
- On 12 November Alisson started and Fabinho came on as a late substitute as Brazil beat Colombia 1-0 at home to reach the 2022 finals.
- Robertson missed Liverpool's win on Saturday with the thigh injury he suffered against Denmark, while Joe Gomez has been sidelined by a calf problem.
- James Milner (hamstring) and Naby Keïta (shin) both picked up injuries at Manchester United; the former has not played since while Keita started in the 2-2 home draw against Brighton on 30 October but was forced off midway through the first half with a hamstring injury of his own and has not featured since.
- Curtis Jones, whose last appearance came in that Brighton game, has been sidelined by an eye injury picked up in training.
- Roberto Firmino suffered a hamstring injury on Matchday 4 and has not played since.
- Thiago Alcántara was out between 18 September and 3 November with a calf injury. He made his first start in two months for the Reds on Saturday.
- Harvey Elliott has been out since suffering a dislocated ankle in a 3-1 win at Leeds on 12 September.
- Salah is on the 30-man shortlist for the Ballon d'Or, with the winner to be announced on 29 November.

### **Porto**

- Porto were 5-1 winners at home to second division Feirense in the last 32 of the Portuguese Cup on Saturday, Otávio scoring twice – his first club goals since last season's semi-final second leg.
- Matheus Uribe was also on target, his first goal since 28 August, while Evanilson made it three in his last four appearances and Francisco Conceição's penalty was his first goal for Porto's senior team.
- Porto are still unbeaten in this season's Portuguese Liga (W9 D2), scoring 28 goals and conceding only seven in their 11 matches.
- A 3-0 win at Santa Clara on 7 November extended Porto's unbeaten run in the Portuguese league to 39 games (W30 D9).
- Luis Díaz's double helped Porto to secure the points at Santa Clara, making it nine Liga goals this season. The Colombian is the leading scorer in the Liga and also Porto's top scorer in all competitions on 11 goals.

- Díaz had scored in three consecutive matches for Porto for the first time since October 2019 before drawing a blank as a substitute on Saturday. His 11 goals this season have already equalled his total from his 47 matches in 2021/22.
- Marko Grujić was an unused substitute in Serbia's 2-1 win away to Portugal on 14 November and became the first Porto player to qualify for next year's FIFA World Cup. Pepe missed that match in Lisbon through suspension.
- Portugal beat Cyprus 6-0 at home on 16 November in 2023 UEFA European Under-21 Championship qualifying with Fábio Vieira on the scoresheet. João Mário also started that match but was replaced on 50 minutes after picking up a knock.
- Pepe became the oldest player to play an official match for Porto in the first round of this season's Portuguese Liga. The Dragons' captain was aged 38 years 163 days when they beat Belenenses on 8 August, eclipsing the record of former goalkeeper Silvino.
- The win against Santa Clara was Sérgio Conceição's 39th successive Portuguese Liga match without defeat, the third longest run for a Porto coach behind Bobby Robson (53 matches) and Vítor Pereira (43).
- Wendell suffered a knee injury against Milan on Matchday 3, returning as a substitute on Saturday.
- The Estádio do Dragão celebrated its 18th birthday on 16 November. Sérgio Conceição is the coach who has overseen the most matches at the venue (112) while former goalkeeper Helton holds the appearance record for players (159).
